Billing Procedure

Dear Southwest Rotarians:

Your Board of Directors has approved the following invoicing procedures. Members will be invoiced quarterly, June 1st, September 1st, December 1st and March 1st for the upcoming quarter's dues, meals and foundation raffles. Monthly invoices will be sent to reflect all other charges to the members

account during the previous month (socials, guests, miscellaneous donations, etc.). Invoicing by e-mail is the preferred club method. Special requests for invoicing by mail can be made to the treasurer.

All accounts will be due in 30 days. A 30-day grace period will be provided before late charges calculated at 1.5% per month will be applied to each account. Any account that becomes delinquent beyond 120 days will be subject to collection actions by the club.

New members are offered to have all invoices charged to a credit card to simplify the billing procedure. Payment by check is also accepted. You may elect to have all charges handled on your credit card or you may provide the credit card information as a security deposit for your account. Invoices over 60 days old will automatically be charged to your credit card on file. If a discrepancy is found on your bill, a credit can be issued to your charge card upon written notification to the Treasurer.

These procedures will be come effective July 1, 2003.
