## Brisbane

- 3908 clubs were represented in Brisbane
- There were 4332 people actually voting on issues
- Attendance was between 16-17,000
- Only 1960 cases of polio were reported worldwide in 2002
- It was announced that \$88,557,000 was raised worldwide for Polio Plus, North America raised \$54,409,000
- Dues will increase for each club in 2005 to cover the deficits in the RI treasury

Resolution 29-12, adopted at the 1929 convention of Rotary International, provides that a member club desiring to request the cooperation of other Rotary clubs, in connection with any matter whatsoever, shall first submit its purpose and plans to the respective district governor or governors and secure their approval: and that no member club shall solicit financial aid from any other Rotary club or from individual Rotarians unless and until it first secures an authorization from the Board of Directors of RI.
