- Our total district membership is apr. 3,370 Rotarians.
- Club sizes in our district range from 11 members in Princeton to 390 members in Milwaukee.
- Our original District 9 was formed in 1915, ten years after Rotary was founded in 1905. The district was restructured in 1957 and again in 1991.
- In 1987, women were admitted for Rotary membership. Our first female District Governor (DG) was Angela Rester Samse of Menominee Falls, elected in 1998.
