The Rotary Internation
Foundation is the "checkbook"
for RI. Half of the contributions
are used to support international
projects. Half of the funds given
by our district come back to
District 6270 in the form of
grants. The Foundation also has
a Permanent Fund which acts as
the "savings account"
endowment fund – contributions
to the Permanent Fund are
separate from contributions to
the RI Foundation.

In 2008, 39 Southwest Rotarians were noted as Sustaining Members, designated as having contributions of \$100 to \$199 annually, and five were noted has Double Sustaining Members with annual contributions of \$200 to \$999.

As multiple Paul Harris Fellow recipient, Jim Chitwood, pointed

out, with a small contribution to the RI Foundation of \$25 each quarter, over time the contribution adds up and before you know it you're a Paul Harris Fellow!
