Irish Fest

Lori Davis thanked the club & those who volunteered as well as those who attended.

This successful event welcomed more than 8,000 guests, from as far as Ohio, a bus from Chicago, and many people from Milwaukee. There were 268 participants in the 5K run.

The mass had over 400 attendees. We had more than 250 volunteers assist. As many as 12 different non-profit/charity groups will benefit from this event. More than 160 kegs of beer were emptied. Vendors merchandise sold more in Oshkosh than they did the previous weekend in Chicago. The two ATM machines ran out of cash three times. Our website had 12,400 visits with 39,800 page views. Twenty-some radio stations and two network TV participated stations in promotions. Six different publications newspaper featured articles and photos. And, every single performing group told us that this was one of the best run festivals they have performed. Not bad, considering this was only our first year! As a board member, on behalf of Irish Fest, I'm proud to present a check to Southwest Rotary. Yes, there will be a second Oshkosh Irish Fest and yes, it will be even bigger and better than this year.
