## Battle on Bago

The Battle on Bago Committee invites fellow Southwest Rotarians to support the 3rd Annual Battle on Bago to be held February 26th and 27th at Menominee Park, Oshkosh. Although we have raised \$20,000 in cash donations and approximately \$20,000 in raffle donations, we are still looking for additional support prior to the event in two months. Possible ways to support include:

1. Sponsorship (Corporate or Individual). Donations have ranged from \$100 to \$5,000. A \$100 bill can purchase 8 fishing pole combos for youth to use year-round.
2. Raffle Prizes. The more value we have on our raffle the more tickets we sell. We have some large items including ATV's and hunting/fishing trips; however the \$50 to \$100 items create a majority of the winners. We budget around 60 prizes for the raffle and the less we have to spend the more goes towards the bottom line.
3. Volunteer: We are forming sub-committees right now and can use 1 hour or 100 hours of your time. Committees will be split up into: Marketing, Raffle Prizes, Ticket Distribution, Finance, Set-up / Take down, etc... Please let us know what area you'd be interested in.
4. Enthusiasm: The event and prize values sell themselves. Just getting the word out to people

that may have never heard about this young event is most important. We do offer a similar program as the Super Bowl Raffle where Youth programs and Conservation Clubs can earn 60% of raffle ticket sales to benefit their organization. Our money is made through ticket sales.
