The third annual Battle on Bago fishing tournament will be held on February 26 and 27 at Menominee Park and on the frozen waters of Lake Winnebago. This event has grown in just three years to be one of the largest fundraising events of the year for our club. This year the committee has already raised \$20,000 in cash donations and an additional \$20.000 in raffle donations (there's still room and need to help in both areas if you're interested). With only a moth to go, Battle on Bago committee members are looking to put the finishing touches on another successful ice fishing tournament and fundraiser.

Sponsorships are still available: they range from \$100 to \$5,000. That \$100 sponsorship can purchase eight fishing pole combos for youth to use year-round.

Raffle prizes: The more prizes the more tickets we'll sell – it's as simple as that. While the prize selection is already amazing, there is room for more. Think outside of the traditional box. If you have a connection to hunting/fishing trips, gear, or anything unique now is the time to tell a committee member.
