#### Tower Project Survey

Thank you to everyone who participated in last week's advisory survey about plans to construct an observation tower / nautical point of reference on the shore of Lake Winnebago in Menominee Park.

Out of 65 total votes cast:

**39 (60%) voted:** "I support the project and believe SW Rotary should continue to spearhead the effort"

**13 (20%) voted:** "I do not support the project and believe SW Rotary should abandon or transfer the project to another group to continue"

**13 (20%) voted:** "I believe the project should be put on hold until we experience better economic times and the public might be more receptive to a capital campaign"

Among the comments, were: "make it 100 ft or the ability to make 100 ft," "move ahead!," "Put up a 75' pole w/light up," "we shouldn't force the

community to have something it doesn't want, the vision was great but just seems to lack support," "I'd be in favor of alternative to a tower," "I support the tower and believe it should be transferred to another group to continue," "keep project going but do capital campaign in better economic times... and then do another vote."
