Kenya Hospital

Last week, the Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club general membership voted in favor of transferring the following line items funds in the International portion of the present Rotary budget to the Kenya Portion of the World project for use in the Kaliluni Medical Center.

\$1,000 was moved from India Surgeries, \$1,000 was moved from Outbound Exchange, and an additional \$1,350 was moved from the Peru fund to help keep the Kenya project moving forward. The transferred funds will not affect programs or services in any of the areas in which they were removed.

Once complete the Kaliluni Medical Center will offer services to the 22,000 people living in the Kaliluni villages. These additional funds will be used to help the KMC affiliate with a much larger hospital for help with operations. The funds will be used to repaint and clean up the facility, finish installation

of electric in the building, install locks and handles on all doors, enhance the landscape, install medical equipment and furniture and other finishing touches to make KMC attractive. Thank you to everyone for supporting this project.
