
June Rotary Meetings

Congratulations Bill Thimke

Each year, Rotary International recognizes the achievements of 150 individuals with the "Service Above Self Award." This year, our own Bill Thimke received the honor at the District 6270 Conference.

The "numbers" reveal this award is a really big deal. Globally, there are more than 1.2 million Rotarians; 33,000 Rotary Clubs; and 550 Rotary Districts. Each district gets to nominate one person for this award which means only about one in four districts will have someone recognized. A total of 150 "Service Above Self Awards" are given each year and because of Bill's hard work on the sow coy project, he was selected to be honored.

Bill's efforts began nearly a decade ago and today have grown to include four soy cows in three municipalities in Peru. These soy cows provide milk to 3,000 children each day. As we all know Bill's path hasn't been easy and often his creativity, persistence, a ready smile and a deep understanding of the local culture was the only thing that helped the project move forward.

For his hard work, his success, and his long-term commitment to the children of Peru, Bill Thimke was an obvious choice for this award. Congratulations Bill – you've inspired us all!
