June Rotary Meetings

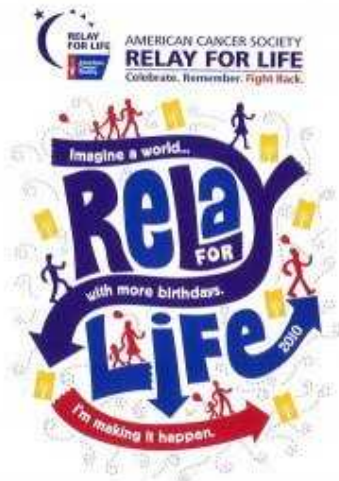
