Live at Lunch June 23rd

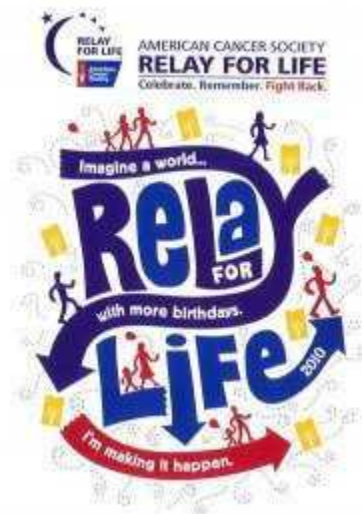
