Live at Lunch Today

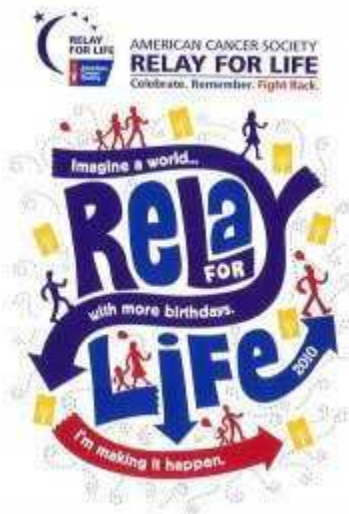
Today's club meeting is being held in Opera House Square, downtown Oshkosh for the "Live at Lunch" series. A roundtable is being held at Robbins.
