The guest speaker will be U.S. Army 1st Lt. Brian Brennan. On May 7, 2008, Brennan was seriously injured in Afghanistan when an IED exploded under the humvee in which he was traveling. The attack took the lives of two soldiers and a civilian. Lt. Brennan suffered cardiac arrest, multiple fractures and traumatic brain injury. He returned home a double amputee.

Lt. Brennan's passion to give back and help others facing the same struggles he endured has led to the establishment of the "Brennan Stands Alone

Foundation." It was created to ease the burden of routine stress for those injured in the line of duty in order that they may focus on treatment and rehabilitation.

Lt. Brennan will share his story and that of the Foundation with those in attendance.
