(RCP 11.030.6.)

The Official Directory of RI shall not be made available by Rotarians. Rotary clubs. or districts for the purpose of circularization. (RCP 11.030.6.) Any club or district directory must include a notice that the directory is not for distribution to non-Rotarians and may not be used as a commercial mailing list. (RCP 11.040.7.)

### **October Rewind**

A look back at events in the Oshkosh history of the Southwest Rotary Club for the month of October (courtesy of President Kris Villars):

October 1974 - Contributions reached an all time high when the Song Book Fund boasted \$1.25 for October and by February they reached \$2.80.

The first Wine & Cheese event was February 27<sup>th</sup>, 1976. The cost was \$5.00 per couple and it was held at the Paine Art Center.

1982 – The Rotary Foundation received an all time giving record of 17.6 Million with 13.308 individuals being recognized with the Paul Harris Fellowships.

October 1992 - John Butler organized the first club auction and dinner which was held at Westhaven Golf Club on October 24<sup>th</sup>. This event raised almost \$6,000 with the proceeds to the Boys & Girls Club.

In 1995 the Boys & Girls Club had moved their annual fundraising event to March. Southwest Rotary's and the Boys & Girls Club events were booked the same weekend and across the street from each other. So the events were which combined has now become Winefeast. In 1995 the amount raised was \$25,000.
