Kaliluni Medical Hospital

Sam Muinde sent some photos of the new Kaliluni Medical Hospital in Kenya, Africa. “I am so grateful to the South West Rotary for the support our club has given me in accomplishing numerous projects to help the many people of my home village of Kaliluni, in Kenya, Africa. The KMH has been one of the stellar projects which is now delivering Health care to a population of 22,000.

South West Rotary has been there with me since the inception of this hospital project five years ago, and we are finally finished. The hospital is operating a very

busy outpatient clinic, and God willing we will have the inpatient in place within three months. We still need help in the purchase of essential equipments for the inpatient wards, and the Laboratory. The Maternity ward will immediately need six bassinets for the new borns, and the Laboratory will need a microscope. There is a great need for an ambulance also. I remain confident that God will help us meet all these needs.

I am attaching pictures of the hospital building plus a picture of the first baby born in the hospital. On behalf of all the people of Kaliluni, I continue to be thankful to our Rotary Club for its generosity in funding KMH project.”
