New Website

Thanks Craig Burnett for a complete redesign of our club's website. Not only does, <u>www.oshkoshrotarysouthest.org</u> look better, but it is more functional than ever.

Some highlights:

A new look - including information for the general public and a private "members only" section.

Public features include the club calendar (importable into Outlook with a single click); Rich Site Syndication (RSS) for calendar events; improved site search; auto-placed news content from Rotary International; RI online videos; and "share this" links so visitors and members can spread the good news via social media.

Member-only features include: individual member login passwords; searchable member interest finder; project planners describing all the important details so members can get involved; easier Hub distribution.

Easy content management- that anybody can do – virtually all content will be able to be maintained by those with no technical knowledge. If your committee needs something on the site – you now have the power to do it, including: selfservice updates by members become immediately visible in the club directory; you can add your own profile photo; update personal interest finder to get involved with club projects that meet your passion; and new member can easily and instantly be added to our on-line roster.

What to do today:

1) Login to the new website and update your member directory listing – especially your Rotary interests. Check your email from 3/2 for complete instructions or ask around for help.

2) If you're in charge of a committee, document how the committee works for our project planner. Login to the member-only area of the website, look on the left for "project planner" and away you go. (If you need an example, use "Scholarship" project for the information you should collect and provide). Information should be sent to the Club President.

3) Show your face! Add your picture to the member directory. The veteran members know you, but the new ones may not. This is a great way to stay connected to your fellow Rotarians.

4) Still confused? Don't be afraid to play around on the website. Experiment with all the bells and whistles – don't worry you can't break it.

Volunteers are still needed to help maintain some content, help train new users, and to keep an active on-line presence. See Craig for more information to volunteer your talents.
