Japan 2011 Shelter Box

We have all seen the devastation in Japan. It is estimated that over 210,000 people have become homeless because of the earthquake and following tsunami. Shelter Box was in Japan within 48 hours after the disaster. This is said to be the worst disaster Japan has seen since WWII.

WE NEED YOUR HELP. Rotary clubs, schools, churches and other groups made a big impact during the Haiti disaster. PLEASE consider a donation to Shelter Box in this GREAT time of need. Shelter Box is also in Madagascar, Bolivia and Peru at this time.
