District 6270 Conference

The 2011 Rotary District 6270 Conference will be held from May 13 through 15 at the Country Spring Conference Center and Water Park in Pewaukee. Hosted by the Hartland-Lake Country Rotary Club the theme is "Building Your Rotary Club in the 21st Century."

Registration costs \$95 per Rotarian.

Spouses and guests that would like to attend the conference break-out sessions are able to sign up for \$25 per person.

Our Board of Directors has approved reimbursing members who attend up to \$65 total for registration costs.

The Saturday evening keynote speaker is UW Madison Athletic Director Barry Alvarez.

Other highlights include "Rotary's Got Talent" showcasing the secret talents of Rotarians from around the district (if you would like to participate visit the district website for more details), a trip to the historic 10 Chimneys site;

and the conference will be held at a water park.

A block of rooms has been reserved through April 28. Rates are \$119 per night or special \$125 per night which includes four passes to the Water Park. Rates include continental breakfast each morning, a USA Today newspaper and free wireless internet. NOTE: You must make your own reservation with Country Springs by calling (262) 547-0201. Make sure to identify yourself as a Rotarian for this special rate.
