**About Today’s Speaker**



Elbert Leander "**Burt**" **Rutan** (born June 17, 1943) is an American aerospace engineer noted for his originality in designing light, strong, unusual-looking, energy-efficient aircraft. He is famous for his design of the record-breaking

Voyager, which was the first plane to fly around the world without stopping or refueling, and the sub-orbital spaceplane SpaceShipOne, which won the Ansari X-Prize in 2004 for becoming the first privately funded spacecraft to enter the realm of space twice within a two week period. He has five aircraft on display in the National Air and Space Museum: SpaceShipOne, the Virgin Atlantic GlobalFlyer, Voyager, Quickie, and the VariEze.

To mark the 25th anniversary of Voyager's flight, EAA and AirVenture will honor Rutan with several events during the week, including a "Tribute to Burt Rutan Day" on Thursday that will include special presentations, a Theater in the Woods program and displays during the daily air show.
