Outbound Update

Sarah, an outbound exchange student from Oshkosh, is currently in Germany. She sent the following email:

I arrived on September 1 after some minor travel problems. My flight from Philadelphia to Frankfurt was delayed 2 hours because fuel gages were not showing the correct amount of fuel in the plane. I guess that is a good reason to keep us on the ground! But I made my connecting flight with no problem. When I arrived in Nurnberg I was very surprised! It is so much bigger than Oshkosh! Nurnberg has about

500,000 people. My host dad was waiting for me at the airport and then brought me to the house. Everyone was waiting for me and we had cake and tea. We walked around the city that night and went out for a "Welcome Sarah dinner."

I have a host sister who is 14 and a host brother who is 6. I play legos with him and play outside on the play ground right by our house. I brought an American football for him and we go out and play with it. My host sister goes to the same school as I do. We go out shopping sometimes or just go biking around the city.

I really like my school. The building is huge however there are only 800 students. I stay with my class most of the day. I am taking German, English, Math, Music, 3 different science classes and some others. My German is coming along. I have started a night class for 3.5 hours every Monday and Wednesday. I also watch cartoons with my host brother which is helping my German improve. For the first month we spoke only English at home and now we are slowly switching over.

I have seen much of the city. I take the tram all around the city to go shopping or just go for a walk! We go on bike rides as a family sometimes which I really like too! Well that is all from here in Germany! Thanks again for sponsoring me! I am having a blast here :)

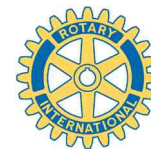
