#### **RI: EREY**



November is Rotary Foundation Month – a perfect time to think about supporting the Every Rotarian, Every Year program.

Every Rotarian Every Year is a Rotary International initiative that encourages all Rotary clubs to help meet the Annual Programs Fund goal of \$104-million for 2011-12. Rotarian support enables funding of local and international projects that advance The Rotary Foundation's mission.

Contributions through "Every Rotarian, Every Year (EREY)" are the primary source of funding for scholarships and grants in the United States and have a huge impact around the world.

For example, a \$100 contribution will provide mosquito nets for 50 children in Tanzania; \$1,000, microcredit loans for 23 women in the Philippines; \$10,000, two water wells to serve villages in Haiti; \$100,000, 100 dairy cows and 50 flocks of chickens to farmers in Romania to produce milk and food for area orphanages.

You can direct your Annual Programs Fund gift to *SHARE*,

the World Fund, or an area of focus fund.

**SHARE** is the primary source of funding for Rotary Foundation programs. It's also the only Annual Fund **Programs** designation that generates funding for the District Designated Fund. Rotary districts use their DDF to pay for the Foundation activities they choose to participate in.

World Fund contributions provide the Foundation's portion of funding for approved grants. Through the World Fund, the Foundation Trustees can allocate funds where the needs are the greatest.

**Areas of focus** contributions provide the Foundation's portion of funding for activities addressing critical humanitarian issues and needs
