Rotary Interact

Thanks to the efforts of many, the Oshkosh community has a growing Interact component:

Alex Wesenberg of the West HS Interact club spoke at the North HS Interact club meetings last Friday. She did a great job of presenting her year abroad in Brazil on a Rotary scholarship. The North HS club meets twice a month on Fridays over the school's two lunch hours. The club has more than 50 registered members.

The West HS club is doing a great job of promoting participation in a number of events, like Race for the Light, Turkey Trot, and the Salvation Army's Red Kettle Campaign.

Both clubs are going to the Badger Sports Park in Appleton for a laser-tag/pizza party. This is in celebration of the **Crop Walk** results of October of this year, in which the clubs raised over 2K between them and helped staff the event. The event overall raised over 8K at last count to combat hunger locally, nationally, and globally.

Wendy Schwalbe of Family Services-Parent Connection will be North's speaker this week.

Ken Arneson CEO of Evergreen has agreed to be a speaker for **North** in December. This is important because the West and North HS clubs are

committed to **offering volunteer service** at Evergreen in the coming months.

The two Oshkosh Interact clubs are working together on making **hats and scarves of polar fleece for students at Roosevelt Elementary School** (and perhaps others) without sufficient warm clothing for recess. Three members of the leadership of the North HS club, all seniors, passed a polar fleece hat on Monday at downtown Rotary and raised almost \$100. Four North HS juniors will pass the hat today, Wednesday, at Southwest, Three freshmen will do likewise this week at the Friday morning club. That this is possible is an index of the fact that leadership is now in place at three grade levels in the North HS club. West HS club members are slated to report back to the adult clubs upon completion of the polar fleece project.

A goal for next year: start an Interact club at Lourdes.

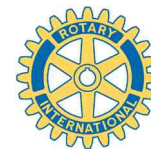
