Battle on Bago

The annual Battle on Bago fishing tournament (and celebration) will be held on February 24 & 25 in Menominee Park. This has quickly grown into one of Southwest Rotary's largest fundraising events.

Battle on Bago was created in 2007 by a group of five Oshkosh Southwest Rotarians in order to vouth support area and conservation efforts throughout Wisconsin. the state of Beneficiaries receiving funds from Battle on Bago embody the mission statement of the event For Kids & Conservation and serve as just the beginning of a long list of organizations and youth Battle on Bago benefit in the future.

Throughout the first four years of this event, it has generated net proceeds of \$10,500 in 2008 (inaugural year), \$40,340 in 2009, \$62,540 in 2010 and \$63,356 in 2011 — \$176,736 total.

More than \$100,000 in fishing and raffle prizes will be given away including cash, County Illinois Hunting trips, guns, fishing vacations. Marcum Locators. Coleman Outdoors Products, Frabill Shacks, Jiffy Augers, and best of all, there are fishing prizes in a variety of placements, tournament including a Lund 1825 Rebel XL Sport with a Mercury 115hp motor for the 200th place winner!

Tentative schedule for the weekend includes the famous fish fry and live music by Copper Box Friday night 5 to 11 p.m.

In addition to the tournament on Saturday (6 am to 1:30 p.m.) there will be a chili cook-off, activities and giveaways for kids, and live music from The Happy Schnapps Combo from 1 to 5 p.m.

The tournament and raffle winners will be announced by emcee John Gillespie around 4 pm and more live music from Sonic Circus will close the event from 7 to 11 p.m.
