More than \$100,000 in fishing and raffle prizes will be given away including cash, County Illinois Hunting trips, guns, fishing vacations, Marcum Locators, Coleman Outdoors Products, Frabill Shacks, Jiffy Augers, and best of all, there are fishing prizes in a variety of

tournament placements, including a Lund 1825 Rebel XL Sport with a Mercury 115hp motor for the **200th place** winner!
