The annual Rotary District 6270 Conference, "An International Affair," will be held at the Heidel House Resort and Conference Center in Green Lake from April 27 to 29.

The conference is hosted by District Governor Nancy Rhodes and The Rotary Club of West Allis.

Early Bird Registration (\$55 per person) ends on March 15 (cost goes up \$10 after March 15). New Rotarians (since July 1, 2011) attending their first district conference can register at the \$55 price at any time. Spouses and guests cost \$20 per person. Sign up today at www.Rotary6270.org.

The conference will features sessions on African storytelling, global health. water and sanitation, and keynote presentations by Amy Currin of Humanitarian Landmine Clearance, PDG Doug Vincent speaking on ways individual Rotarians have made a positive difference in our world, and Fakhira, Kobi & who are working in the Israeli-Palestinian peace movement.

Group Study Exchange Teams (both outgoing and the incoming Australian team) will lead presentations and author Robert Grede will talk about his historic Civil War book.

Returning will be the House of Friendship showcasing service projects by various clubs in our district.

New this year, our conference will have a Service Project. On Friday afternoon from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. join Rotarians to help clean up Zobel Park in Green Lake.

Make sure to sign up for the annual Celebrate Rotary Golf Outing. It will be held on Friday, April 27 at Lawsonia Links, one of Wisconsin's oldest and best rated golf courses.
