District Water Project

Rotary District 6270 currently has a project to distribute water filters in Haiti. With a grant

from the Rotary Foundation, together with donations from Rotary clubs, a non profit foundation and individuals, we will distribute 863 water filters to poor people in the lower central plateau area of Haiti. The Rotary Club of Mirebalais, Haiti is cooperating and overseeing the project.

A donation has enabled us to hire two Haitian men to distribute the filters. They seek out the areas where there is no access to pure water. One such area is Grand Boucan. The picture below shows the water source for these people. Most of the people contracted had a history of diarrheal disease. We will check back in the future to access the effectiveness of the filters.

Each filters costs \$52.00 and consists of a five gallon bucket with lid and attached filter. This filter is reasonably priced, long lasting, low maintenance and has a fairly good flow rate.
