The 6th annual Battle on 'Bago ice fishing tournament will take place on Feb. 22 and 23 in Menominee Park. This is the largest fundraiser of the year for our club and one the largest events of the year in Oshkosh.

Even before the anglers take to the ice our club, and many of our partner organizations, have the opportunity to raise fund through the sale of raffle tickets. 100% of all proceeds generated by our club members through raffle ticket sales will remain with our club.

- 1) **End Polio Now:** At rotary.org you'll find a number of ways to finally eradicate polio in 2013. There's the "world's biggest commercial" and the "light up a landmark" movement on Feb. 23. A little extra effort this year can win the fight against polio.
- 2) **Strategy – Set Club Goals:** Member access on the Rotary.org website has plenty of tools to make all of us more successful Rotarians. Use their assessment tools to set and track goals, such as contributions to the RI Foundation (see #3)
- 3) **Help the Foundation:** Give just \$2 a week to the Rotary International Foundation and before you know it you'll be a Paul Harris Fellow and support all of the great projects Rotarians do around the world. (Also

consider donating \$2 to own foundation and become a Richard Ames Fellow).

- 4) **New Grant Model:** In July, all districts will begin using the Foundations new grant model. Learn about it and take advantage of streamlined funding for our club projects.
- 5) **Get Inspired:** Attend the RI Convention in Lisbon, Portugal in June OR get more involved in training offered by our own Rotary District 6270.
- 6) **Spread the word:** Be proud of our club goals and achievements and make an extra effort to tell people about all the great things we do. Jump on social media and tell the world why you are a Rotarian, what you want to accomplish and then make it happen.
- 7) **Connect with Alumni:** don't forget about former club members. They may be effective speakers for club meetings and some may be looking to get involved again. Reach out to them.
