#### **2012 Giving Summary**

The Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club has posted our 2012 charitable giving summary on our club website, find out who shared \$125, 279 in gifts at www.OshkoshRotarySouthwest. org.

#### **Highlights include:**

\$11,000 in scholarships; \$23,000 to youth clubs from raffle sales proceeds; \$27,000 to the Peru soy Cow Project; our members also contributed nearly \$15,000 to the Rotary International Foundation and our own Southwest Rotary Foundation.

#### **Battle on Bago**

The 6<sup>th</sup> annual Battle on 'Bago ice fishing tournament will take place on Feb. 22 and 23 in Menominee Park. This is the largest fundraiser of the year for our club and one the largest events of the year in Oshkosh. Even before the anglers take to the ice our club, and many of our partner organizations, have the opportunity to raise fund through the sale of raffle tickets. 100% of all proceeds generated by our club members through raffle ticket sales will remain with our club.
