New Programs for Member Assistance

Recently the Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Board of Directors unanimously passed a resolution that would put out a helping hand to any fellow Rotarian from the club that may need financial assistance. We all know that at any time a person may lose their job for various reasons or be inflicted with some other personal financial burden. With this being the case, the club developed two options to help out a member in need by providing temporary assistance until they are able to get their finances back in working order.

The first part of the Member Assistance Program is establishing a fund for financial assistance for members due to loss of employment, health problems or other factors. The assistance would cover the cost of meals and dues for a period up to six months. The following parameters would need to be met: The Rotarian has to be a member in good standing with 60% attendance for the last two years and who has participated in club programs and events. Club members may ask for this assistance for themselves or it can be requested from a fellow club member. The current president and treasurer will determine the member's eligibility and the program will be administered confidentially.

The second part of this program comes under what is called

Member Service. Using the club's website we will provide (if our technology allows) an area for job opportunities from Rotarians and resumes of Rotarians to help those in need of employment and good employees. Complete details are still coming together, but the hope is to provide a place to connect Rotarians for employment opportunities.

We are constantly looking for ways to help those in need. With that concept in mind, let's make sure we help those that are looked upon as being valued members of our organization.
