All Rotary Club's that intend to submit a District Grant and/or a Global Grant are required to have this signed form on file with Mike Slawny.

Club Financial Management Plans are required for clubs with Global Grants. Submit the Club's Financial Management

plan along with the signed MOU to Mike Slawny, msslawny@charter.net. Financial Management Plans are NOT required for Club's applying for funding to do a District Grant. Applications for District Grant funding are Due May 31, 2013. Don't be late with your forms! Only one application for a District Grant per club will be accepted this year.

There will be up to \$36,000.00 of DDF (District Designated Funds) available for District Grants. All materials related to Rotary Grants can be found on the District 6270 Website. Hint – lower left hand side, under heading Future Vision of District website. (Don't confuse with Club Visioning.) Starting July 1, the title/name Future Vision goes away and the new name will be Rotary Grants. Have questions?
