After 25 years of hard work, Rotary and its partners are now "This Close" to eradicating polio. Celebrities from Bill Gates to Ziggy Marley have signed on to help spread the word, and now you can join them. Go to www.ThisClose.net to check out information on how we are "this close" to wiping out polio worldwide.

Polio cases have plunged from about 350,000 cases in 1988 to fewer than 1,300 reported cases in 2010. More than two billion children have been immunized in 122 countries, preventing five million cases of paralysis and 250,000 pediatric deaths.
