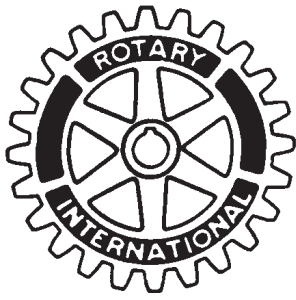

- Purpose:** To provide fellow Rotarians and their guest a convenient place to make up a meeting and meet other Rotarians from around the world.

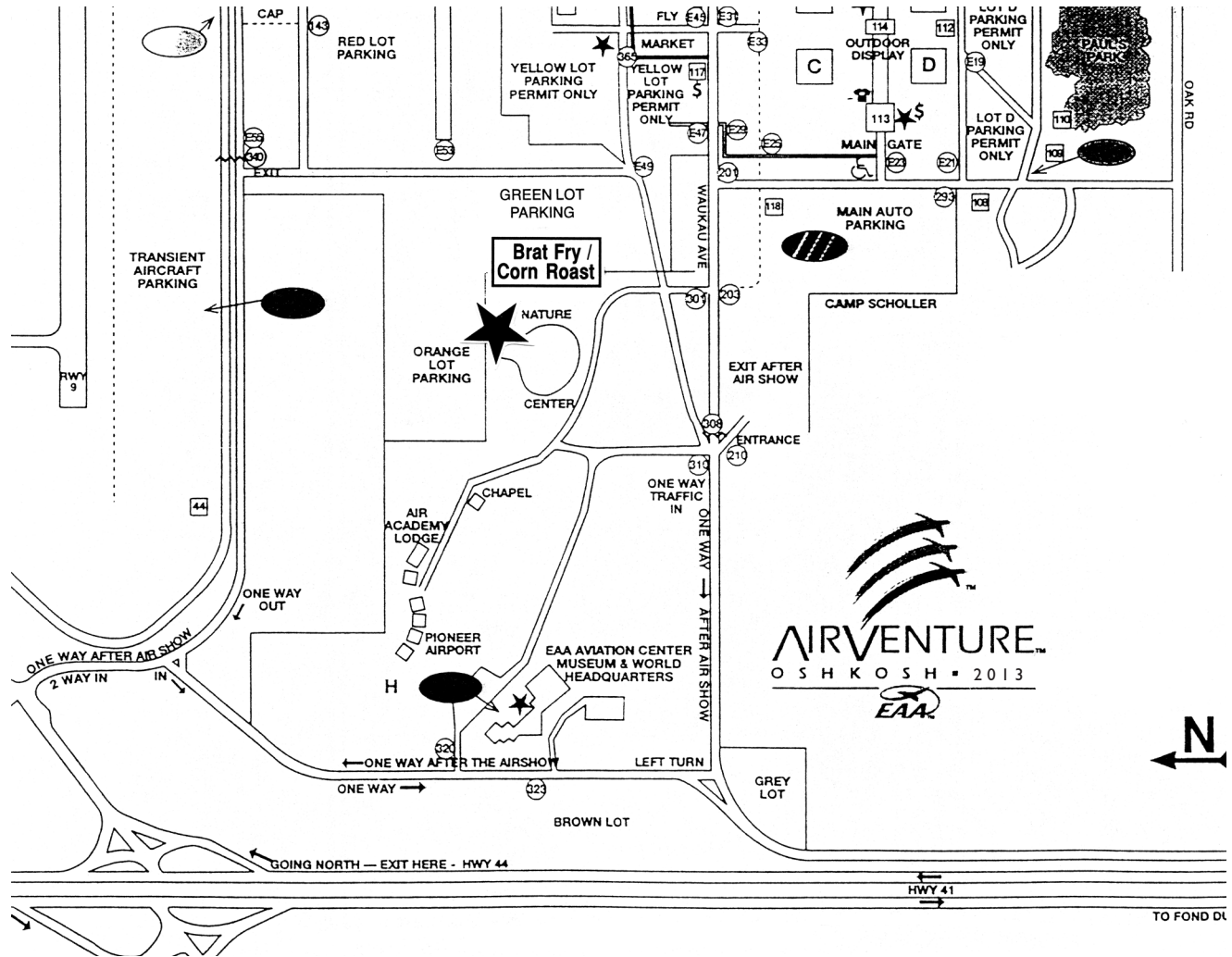
