Rotary Attendance and Make-Up Policy

One of the most important aspects of Rotary is getting and staying involved with your club. Simply put that means attending our weekly meetings. Our club strives to hold its members to a 60% attendance rate. Dip below that level and our Sargent-at-Arms may have to conduct an awkward meeting about staying in good standing in our club. But fear not, even if you miss a weekly meeting there are a number of ways to make up for your absence and approach the goal of perfect attendance for the year.

Make-up meeting credit will be given for any of the following activities:

Attend a Club function: board meeting, committee meetings, highway clean up, e-cycling, anything our club does as a group function will count as a make-up.

Attend another Rotary Club meeting: the downtown club meets at noon each Monday at the Best Western Premier Waterfront Hotel; we also have an e-club that credits you with a make-up for meeting in cyber space; and if you are on vacation, seek out the local Rotary club – it will be a great experience and count as a make-up.

Attend a District Rotary Function: conferences, planning

sessions, training, and GSE team functions all count.

The most important aspect of this is REPORTING YOUR MAKE-UPS to the club secretary! Rotary International bylaws state a member can make up for a missed meeting within 2 weeks before or after the meeting.

Anytime you participate in a Rotary function let our club secretary know about it – if you would like credit as a make-up. Simply pass along the function name, location, date and what missed meeting you would like to apply the make-up. It's that simple.

Committee Chairs and Event Organizers – please make sure to submit your list of attendees to the secretary. All members will appreciate the ease in which they receive make up credit.

If you have any questions or would like to check your attendance number, simply ask when you pick up your badge at our weekly meetings.

Regular engagement is the key to success for any Rotary club.
