Battle on Bago

RETURN YOUR RAFFLE TICKETS TODAY! Please bring your sold raffle tickets to our club meeting today. Our club keeps 100% of the proceeds from tickets sold by our club members.

Battle on Bago will take place Friday and Saturday, February 21 and 22 in Menominee Park. With a \$160,000 prize pool this is the largest ice fishing tournament in the country and it's our largest fundraiser for the year.

In its seventh year Battle on Bago has grown well beyond the original vision of the event when members of our Rotary Club founded a "little fishing tournament."

Today Battle on Bago is its own charitable foundation, governed by its own Board of Directors, but the partnership with our club is still very strong. SW Rotary members will always sit on the BOB board. The partnership

places the bulk of legwork on the Battle on Bago team as they plan, coordinate and execute the event. Our club agrees to provide a minimum of 60 volunteer shifts during the tournament to ensure the BOB team can focus on the anglers and action on the ice. In return our club receives \$20,000 (as long as the event proceeds are at least \$100,000; that minimum is also adjusted annually to account for inflation). Our club also retains 75% of all cash sponsorships sold by club members, 100% of raffle tickets sales from our members, and \$100 "cash back" for donations of raffle prizes valued at \$250 or more. It's a great partnership and one that wouldn't exist without the foresight of the BOB founders and their wish to keep SW Rotary engaged with the event for generations to come.

So volunteer (if you haven't already signed up see Kris Villars) this weekend, tell your family and friends to stop out for the fish fry and live music on Friday or to watch the weigh-ins and prizes being awarded on Saturday.
