Shared Harvest

Shared Harvest is a joint project between SW Rotary and downtown Rotary. The mission is to encourage farmers and gardeners to donate fresh produce to area food pantries. Each week volunteers work at the Oshkosh Farmers market to collect donations of fresh produce. Shared Harvest also helps EBT beneficiaries by exchanging their credits for tokens they use to purchase fresh, healthy food options at the market.

Volunteers are needed to help with this very important project. There are two shifts for the downtown Saturday Farmers Market: 7:45 to 10:30 a.m. and 10:15 to 1 p.m. The first shift helps exchange EBT credits for farmers market tokens. The second shift helps collect produce donations.

Each growing season Shared Harvest literally collects tons of fresh produce.

During the first few weeks of the market we also coordinate the "adoption" of tomato and pepper plants. We ask the new "parents" to plant and then share their harvest with the local pantry.

Volunteers are needed on: June 7 and 21; July 5 and 19, August 2, 16 and 30, September 6 and 20; and October 4 and 18.
