EAA Flying Rotarian Corn Roast

The 29th annual Flying Rotarian's "Wisconsin Style" Brat Fry and Corn Roast will be held at noon on Wednesday, July 30 at the EAA Nature Center on the AirVenture grounds. On the menu: WI fresh brats, hamburgers, hot dogs, corn, coleslaw, vegetables, chips and beverages. This is our annual meeting to welcome Rotarians from around the globe attending EAA's AirVenture. Cost is \$12 per person.

This year's speaker is Gary Powers Jr. He will give a brief overview of the Cold War, the misinformation surrounding the U-2 incident, the family's effort to set the record straight and the current efforts to honor Cold War veterans and preserve Cold War history to education future generations. About the U-2: Following World War II, the United States instituted high altitude reconnaissance flights over the Soviet Union because of an aura of mistrust between the two countries. The CIA used the U-2 for spying missions, keeping the military out of the picture to avoid any possibilities of open combat. By 1960, the US had flown numerous "successful" missions but on May 1 a U-2 spy plane piloted by Francis Gary Powers was shot down near Sverdlovsk, Soviet Union. The details on this event are to this day shrouded in mystery.

Powers' book, "Operation Overflight: A Memoir of the U-2 Incident" is an update to the 1970 classic by pilot Francis Gary Powers.
