Bowling FUN-Raiser

Our annual bowling FUN-raiser is Thursday, October 23 at Oshkosh Lanes. If you've never attended before you probably don't understand the game. While the goal is to raise money for our rotary club, it's also one of the most FUN times you'll have this year with your fellow Rotarians.

Here's how it works: you show up, bowl a little bit, and enjoy food and drinks and lots of laughs.

The fundraiser side is pretty easy too. Sponsor teams pledge \$300 for each bowler and then subtract \$1 for each pin they knock down from the total gift.

Individual bowlers do the same (\$300 pledge minus the total number of pinks knocked down in one game).

You can also join as a ¹/₂ bowler, a 1/3 bowler or a ¹/₄ bowler (spilt your pledge and bowling game with as many as three other people). And finally, if you just want to show up and be a "cheerleader" that's just a \$15 donation.

Sign up today and make plans to attend the second largest, but most fun, fundraising event of the year for our Rotary club.
