Paul Harris Fellow

The Paul Harris Fellow recognition, named after the founder of Rotary, acknowledges individuals who contribute, or who have contributions made in their name, of \$1,000 to The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International. It was established in 1957 to show appreciation for and encourage substantial contributions to what was then the Foundation's only program, Rotary Foundation Fellowships for Advanced Study, the precursor to Ambassadorial Scholarships. In 1969, the Foundation unveiled the first Paul Harris Fellow medallion to acknowledge contributors.

Today, generous contributions to The Rotary Foundation are essential to securing and growing Rotary programs throughout the world. Donors are recognized with a pin and certificate indicating their support for Rotary and inclusion in this prestigious, and important, subset of Rotary membership.

But it's not just Rotarians who enjoy the Paul Harris Fellow award as many clubs, including Oshkosh Southwest Rotary, use the distinction to honor notable contributions in their own communities by non-Rotarians.

The Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club is proud to annually present community members with honorary Paul Harris

Fellow awards to mark their positive contributions to the Oshkosh Community.

Recipients are nominated by club members and voted on by members of the club's board of directors.

These awards are funded through annual club donations to The Rotary Foundation.

Individual club members are also recognized for lifetime contributions of \$1,000 (and additional gifts of \$1,000 increments).

Many members of our club have already received their Paul Harris Fellow recognition and many others are on track to receive theirs in the coming years through their weekly donations.

You can check your progress towards this recognition on the Rotary.org website at any time.

Funds raised support Rotary International projects such as eradicating polio, promoting peace, and provide grants to approach help solve challenges such as poverty, illiteracy and malnutrition.
