team (and to show you are thankful you didn’t get recruited to dance) please give a donation at

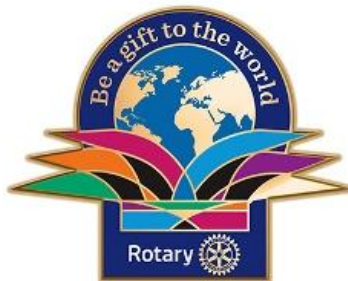
