#### Flying Rotarian Picnic

Today is the 30<sup>th</sup> annual Oshkosh Southwest Rotary “Wisconsin Style” Brat Fry and Corn Roast on the Experimental Aircraft Association grounds.

Join us as we welcome fellow Rotarians from around the world for our annual meeting as part of the AirVenture convention. From noon to one p.m. we’ll enjoy brats, burgers and hotdogs; corn on the cob, cole slaw, chips beverages and more. Lunch will be served inside the pavilion at the EAA Nature Center. Parking is free from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Nature Center (if you are planning on going onto the AirVenture grounds you will need an admission and parking pass).

Our speakers will be members of the flight crew for the new Goodyear Airship: Eddie Ogden, Michael “Doc” Dougherty and Glenn Leonardi.

*Wingfoot One* is the first of Goodyear’s new generation of

semi-rigid airships. First flown in spring 2014, the airship was manufactured by Germany’s ZLT Zeppelin Luftschifftechnik and assembled by a team of Zeppelin and Goodyear engineers. It represents the first major structural change of a Goodyear airship in nearly 70 years.

The new airship features advanced on-board avionics and flight control systems with the capability to travel at faster speeds and hover in place. The spacious passenger gondola will provide an enhanced in-flight experience with sweeping, panoramic windows.

*Wingfoot One* arrived in Oshkosh on Tuesday and will be on display and fly at the event through Sunday. EAA AirVenture attendees will have the opportunity to see *Wingfoot One* perform in various air shows and meet the *Wingfoot One* pilots at a variety of events ranging from autograph sessions to forum presentations.

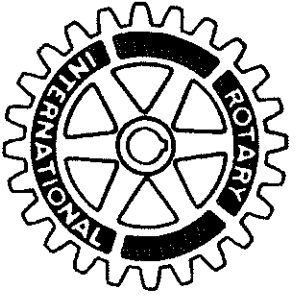

**Purpose:** To provide fellow Rotarians and their guest a convenient place to make up a meeting and meet other Rotarians from around the world.

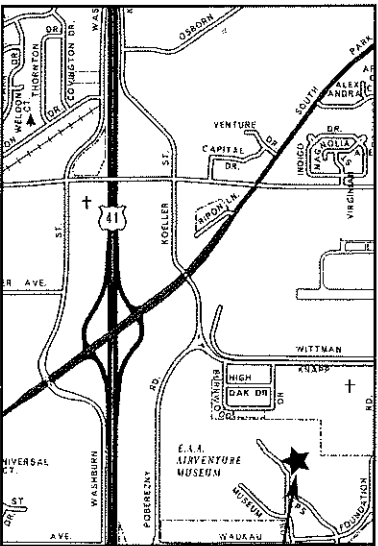
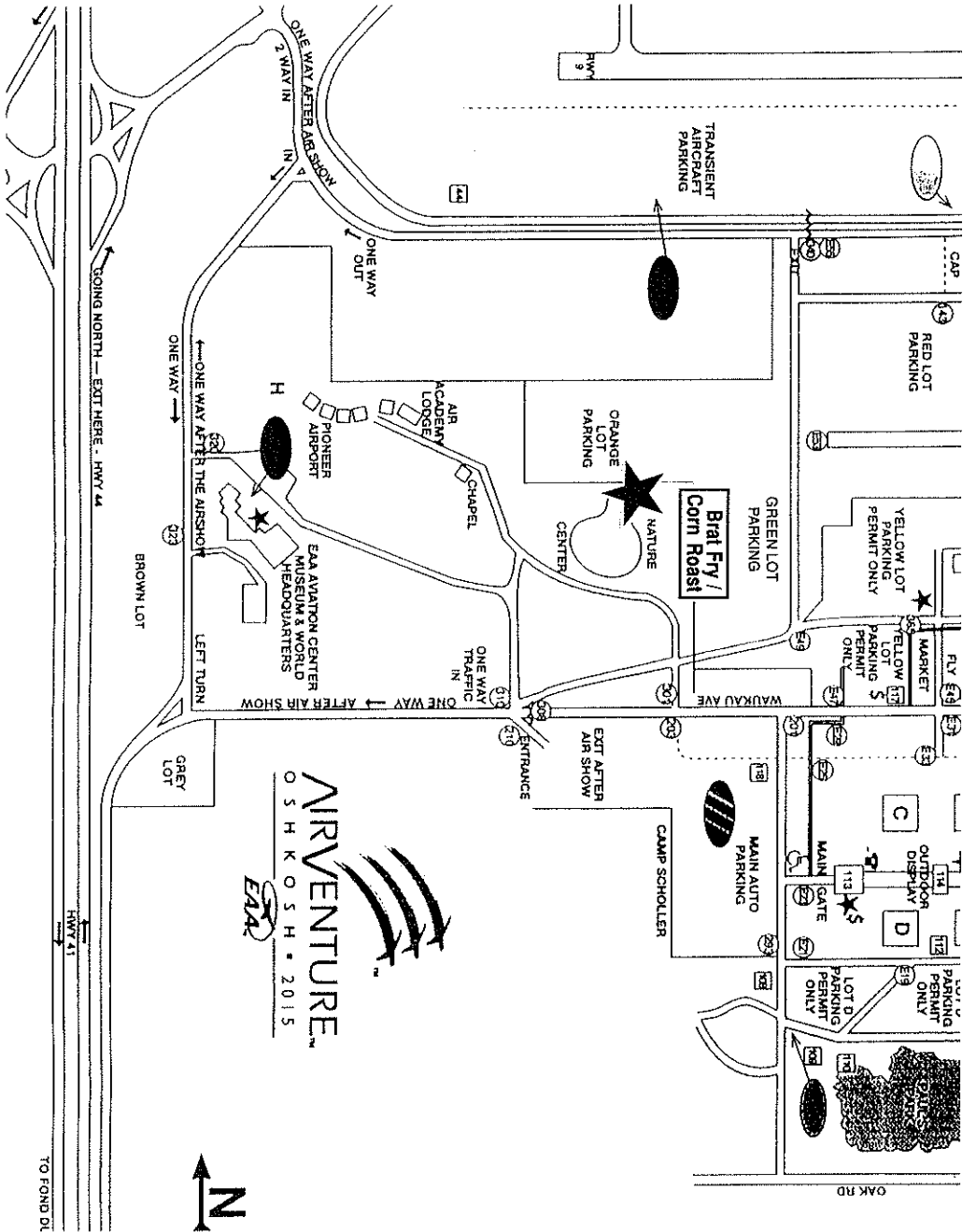
