That is nearly 1000 youth in our community who went to their first day of school with new backpacks, school supplies and even some needed toiletries, all because of the generous donations of this club and others in the community.

And, let's not forget the 211 volunteers that helped with the Fair, including some of our own Southwest Rotarians. A big Thank You to all. The Back to School Fair was started in 1998 in an effort to give every student a chance to start the new school year with the confidence that a new backpack, clothes, shoes and school supplies can bring. It serves the Oshkosh and Winneconne School Districts.
