Today we celebrate the extraordinary efforts of the Rotarians who have been instrumental in the development and success of Battle on Bago.

In 2007 members of the Oshkosh Southwest Rotary created a trademark event after seeing the growing issue of youths being stuck behind a television or computer screen. They decided to rally the community to help fund efforts to get youth outdoors and involved in local conservation efforts. Since its inception, Battle on Bago has raised close to \$500,000 and given it back to the community. Battle on Bago has become an epic event held in February each year. It is the biggest ice fishing tournament in the United States. This year the event will host over 10,000 fisherman and give \$250.000 awav over in fishing and raffle prizes. Southwest Rotary Making Progress in Peru

First off, thanks to Bill Thimke for the exceptional work he has been doing in Peru. He has gone above and beyond and we couldn't thank him enough. He gave the club a great update last week!

Secondly, the amount of work we have done in Peru is extraordinary. After a rough time getting started in Peru, we should all be very proud of what we have accomplished. We currently operate 3 soy milk plants in the suburbs of Lima. One is located in the city of LaMolina, a city of 60,000 people. The additional 2 are located in Ate, a city of 600,000 people. We produce more than 5,000 8 oz. servings of high protein milk every day. We have also added a bakery, a dental clinic and library.

Again, none of this would have been possible without the continued support of the members!
