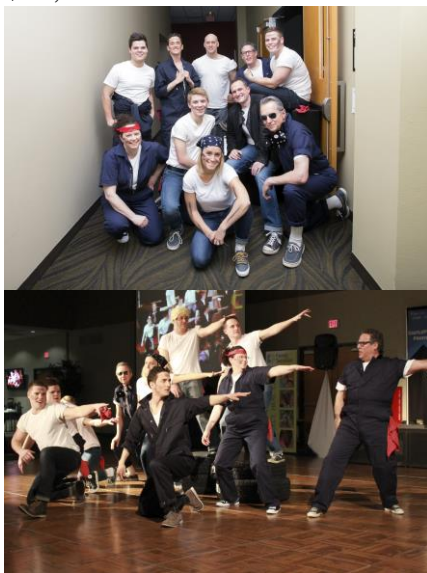
Dancing For Little Stars
