The Foundation chairs recently introduced to the club – the Circle of Five.

The idea behind it is to increase Paul Harris Fellow’s in the club, by newer members, and encourage more giving from non-contributing members.

Here’s on it works:

Five existing PHF with credits invites a member that wants to become a PHF. The new member agrees to contribute \$2 per week and be willing to continue as a sustaining member of PHF. Each year the 5 credit the new member with \$100 each. At the end of year 2 the new person becomes a PHF and the group becomes six.

At this time the group can:

-Start a new group or can continue as is based on the group’s decision.

-A new member can be identified and the process starts over.
