Summer Battle on Bago THIS WEEKEND!!!

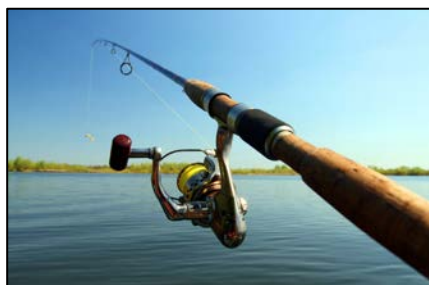
Thank you to everyone that has signed up to volunteer for the Battle on "Bago Summer Edition!
