November is Foundation Month



There are many ways in which Rotarians can contribute to the Rotary Foundation – for those of us who are over 70½ it is now possible to make tax-free charitable gifts directly from **Individual Retirement Accounts** (IRAs). This giving option had been available at times in the past and was made permanent in December 2015. If you have a traditional (or Roth) IRA, you can now make gifts directly to The Rotary Foundation using funds that might otherwise be taxed when withdrawn. You may choose to make charitable gifts directly from an IRA up to a total of \$100,000 per person per year. By giving directly from your IRA you also won't increase your adjusted gross income or possibly subject your Social Security to a higher level of taxation. (Whow!) (Got that?) Another advantage is your gift will count toward your Required Minimum Distribution, and you can avoid taxes on income while you help Rotary improve communities around the world.

For those under 70½ you will have to wait until you reach that birthday – but it is just as easy to contribute to The Rotary Foundation by using Rotary Direct, For signing up for The Rotary Foundation's recurring giving program - just go to: www.rotary.org/give!

No matter how you give, The Rotary Foundation will continue "to do good in the world!" Thank you.
