Participant Ages: 2-100 years old. Children ages 4 and under are encouraged to have an older sibling or adult run with them.

Fee: \$10.00/person which includes headband, refreshments and entry into Rib Fest. Fee to be collected upon check-in on day of event. Registration prior to race day is encouraged; however, there will be onsite registration beginning at 8am on Sept 3rd.
