Today's speaker is Jeff Buchta, CEO and **Executive Director of Tri-County Dental.** Jeff is the second to be at the helm of TCC following Robert Glass who retired due to illness. Jeff came to TCD with a diverse background in industry with his most recent position being Vice President of Sales for WS Packaging. The concept of a Tri-County Dental clinic began in 2002 when a life study of Fox Cities indicated that 25,000 people living in Winnebago, Outagamie, and Calumet counties were uninsured, or underinsured and not able to afford basic dental care. With that in mind a group of local dentist and community leaders began a plan to build and staff an all-volunteer 10 chair dental clinic to serve this need.

Their mission-- Tri-County Dental is a volunteer-based dental clinic whose mission is to provide quality oral health care in a caring and compassionate manner. Serving individuals in Calumet, Outagamie and Winnebago counties whose access to dental health care is limited due to low income or receiving Medicaid benefits.
