Oshkosh Service League Sex Trafficking in the Fox Valley

TODAY'S SPEAKERS



The Service League of Oshkosh is steeped in history, dating back 85 years. The organization was started in 1928 by a group of women who sought to assist during wartime efforts. A mainstay in downtown Oshkosh for more than 70 years, the Service League's thrift shop was its primary means of raising funds, in addition to an annual auction.

An endowment fund was created with the Community Foundation in 2004 to support the group's mission of benefitting women and children in the community. "We just felt this was a good way to keep the Service League alive forever", says Nancy Albright, one of 18 members of the group. "The fund has grown and (we have given money away) to organizations that fit our mission. We always like giving money away - it's always more fun than making it."

Our speakers will give us an update on the extent of sex-trafficking in the area and their program designed to limit its extent and help its victims.

City, the Oshkosh
North Communities
Program and SW
Rotary have ...

- Made brief presentations to the OHNI Neighborhood Committee, the leaders and/or boards of 5 individual neighborhood associations and the Roosevelt School PTO.
- Made two presentations to general neighborhood meetings, reaching several dozen home owners.
- Educated 300 4th and 5th graders at Roosevelt, Webster, Washington and Emmeline Cook Elementary Schools, each of whom took a brochure and a their own storm sewer inlet drawing home to their parents
- Presented to the Oshkosh Storm Water Management Board.
- Installed almost 1,000 storm water inlet medallions and passed out storm water brochures to over 4,000 homes in River East, Steven's Park, the University District, the North High Neighborhood and the area around West High and Roosevelt Elementary.
- Received publicity on WOSH and WFRV.

There will be future presentations to the Oshkosh SW Rotary and to a Fox River Watershed Conference in Lambeau Field.

That is a job well done. Thank you for supporting the project.
